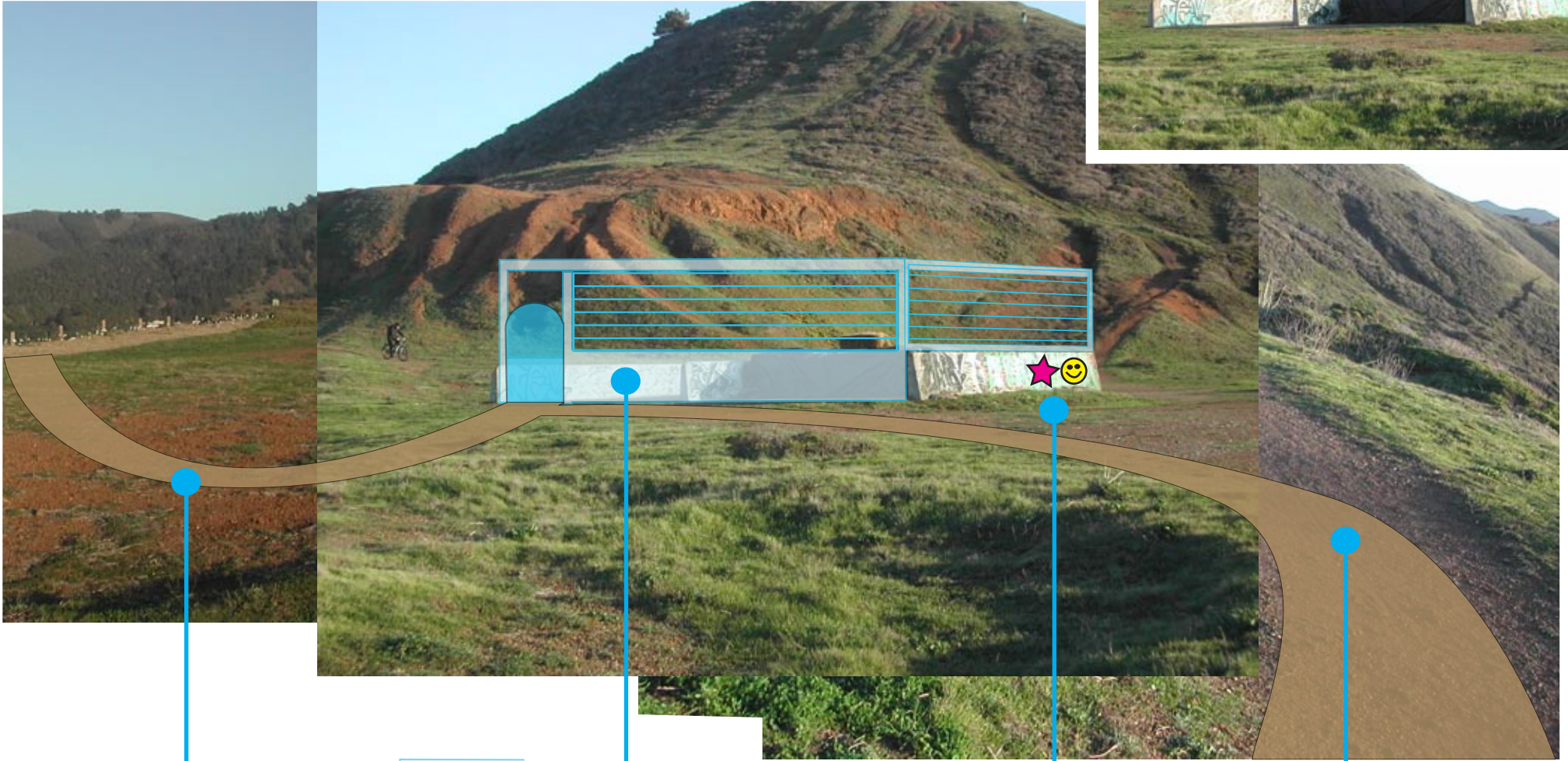


Community Garden Ideas (1 of 2 pgs.)

Path added to connect existing trail with ADA ramp at the base of the fire road.

Siding added to enclose all 4 sides (no roof) with a gate for the entrance. The lower cement slabs would remain in place to be part of the enclosed structure and foundation.

School kids could have the opportunity to paint their own mural on the exterior side of the existing cement slabs.

The existing path coming up the hill (ascending from the long stretch of steps) could be more clearly defined and also branch to the entrance.

What would be in it?

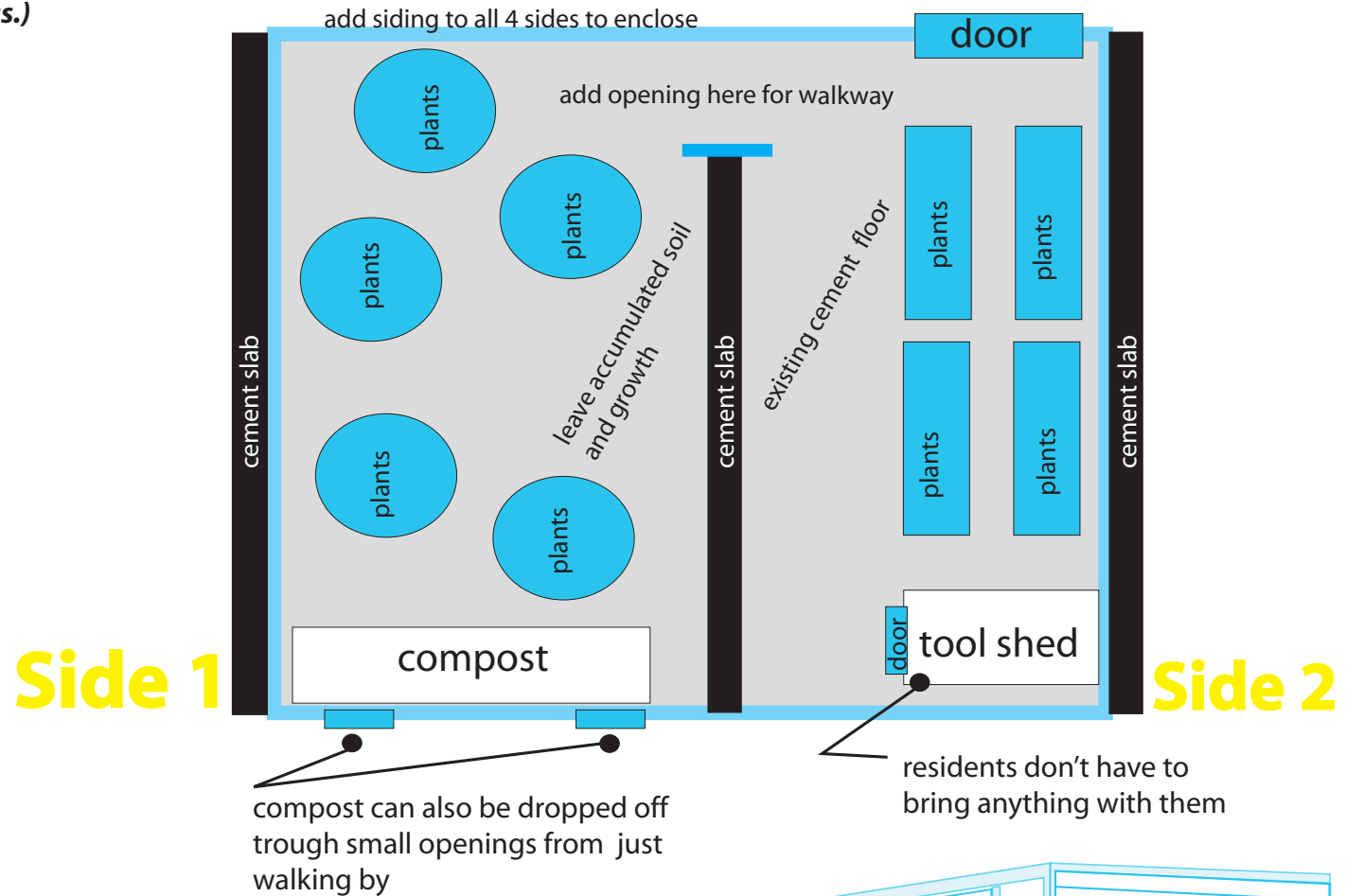
This could be decided by each group participating as part of their (for ex.) class assignment or interest of their organization.

Issues to Consider:

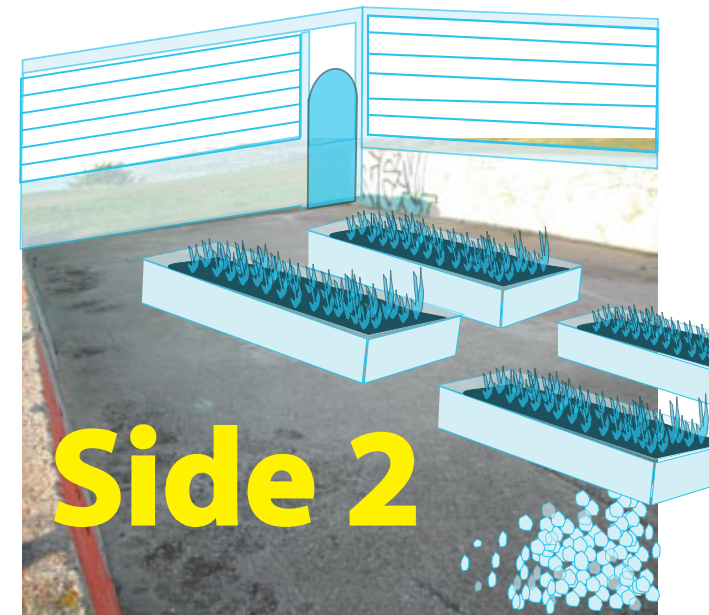
- Weathering Prevention
